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French team became aware of biotechnology research work.

Pantnagar(Panjab Keshari) . With the aim of promoting mutual cooperation in agriculture and food related sectors, a sixteen member team from France reached Uttarakhand Council for Biotechnology, Haldi, Pantnagar and learned about the research and development activities taking place there.
